

STAIRCASE: HOUSE AT BESSERUD, OSLO, NORWAY

This winder stair, formed in a square well, is supported on the inside by a laminated timber string which is twisted through an angle of 360° and serves as a newel post. The steps are supported on their outside edge by bent steel rods built into the fairface brickwork. The broad effect of this rather elaborate artifice is to give full value to the space of the well.
